JOB GOAL: To structure a learning environment within a summer camp which will provide academic continuity and support for students during the summer months. Students will show evidence of fulfilling their potential for intellectual, emotional, and social growth and maturation.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Meets and instructs campers in the location and for the duration of time designated.
2. Designs engaging and creative lesson plans for campers entering grades 1-5 per the weekly assigned subject (literacy, science, math, etc.).
3. Develops and maintains a classroom environment conducive to effective learning.
4. Prepares for classes assigned, and shows written evidence of preparation upon request of Coordinator/WWS Supervisor.
5. Sets and maintains appropriate standards of classroom behavior.
6. Employs a variety of effective instructional techniques.
7. Implements district initiatives and instructional goals and objectives.
8. Takes all necessary and reasonable precautions to protect students, equipment, materials, and facilities.
9. Provides a systematic, well-documented summary of campers' progress over the course of the instruction.
10. Upholds and enforces school and camp rules, administrative regulations, Board policy, state and federal law.
11. Assists in the selection of books, equipment and/or other instructional materials.
