## Keep My Street Green Program: Storm Drain Audit



**Here's the Challenge!** Audit a street by capturing photos of storm drains that are **unsafe to the environment**. Upload them using the *iVolunteer App* (link posted below). In order to complete Parsippany's storm drain audit, we need to capture over 900 streets and over 100 business locations by **August 15th**, and we're going to need your help to meet this goal! Volunteers completing 10 or more streets will be recognized by the Parsippany Green Team. Best of all, students can earn Community Service hours by taking part in this important effort.

**Why are we doing this?** According to recent estimates, there's over **220 Million tons** of plastic in the Atlantic Ocean, and each year it's growing by almost 2%. Plastic debris from our drains goes into local streams and ultimately goes right into the ocean, *but it doesn't have to be this way!*
