


Tuesdays, October 2, 9, 16, 23 6:00-6:45 pm **Team Up for Reading** (Kindergarten-5th grade) Teen volunteers will work with the students in small groups. Children will read a book, discuss the book to improve reading comprehension, play educational games, and complete writing activities. Please register once for the October session. Registration is required and will begin on September 24. This program is sponsored by a grant from Target.

Wednesday, October 3, 4:30pm **Read to a Dog** For ages 5 and older. Sign up to read to a therapy dog. Registration required. Each child may register for one session only.

Thursday, October 4 4:15-5:00 pm **Origami Hat Storytime** (ages 4-6) Children will listen to stories about hats. Then Mrs. Kwan will teach the children how to make an origami hat. Each child will make and decorate a hat to take home. Registration is required and will begin on September 24.
