****If this is your first time registering for any program with the Parsippany Recreation Department, please submit a copy of your child's 2016-2017 report card to prove residency & age. If the report card does not show a child's address, a copy of the utility bill must accompany it. All registered children MUST be Township of Parsippany residents. If you are registering in person, please bring the documents with you at registration. If you are registering online, you must submit the documents within 1 week of completing registration. Failure to do so, will result in a withdrawal of your child from the program.**

Children can be dropped off any time after 8:30am but MUST be picked up before 12:30pm. If a child is not picked up by 12:30pm, the police will be called and the child will be then be in police custody.

We recommend sending each child with snacks, drinks (preferably water bottles) as food will not be provided. We also recommend children wear sneakers EVERY day as the activities vary each day. We do not recommend children bring electronic devices or valuables to the program as we are not responsible for them. We cannot guarantee a device or item will not get lost or broken.

Each day, the children will have various activities planned that they may participate in. The activities include but are not limited to arts & crafts, soccer, wiffleball, basketball, volleyball, playground time, open field time and other youth activities. Some weeks might be themed so be sure to get your activity flyer from the counselors each week so you are aware of what is going on. There may also be food days in which your children can participate in for an additional charge. Money must be submitted by the deadline in order for your child to participate. There may also be requests from the program for the child to bring a specific item in for certain activities such as a t-shirt for tie dye day.

Trip Information will be released at a later date. All trips will have additional fees. The program may be closed on certain trips if a child is not registered. Children MUST wear their Parsippany Recreation Playground T-shirt on all Trips. **Trip drop off & pick up will for all half day locations will ALL take place at Veterans Memorial Park located at 1839 Route 46, Parsippany.**

Please take into consideration any allergies your child might have. Our program is not a nut free program as we are located at a public park. Our policy is that if any child who has an epi-pen needs to be able to administer it themselves. A child who brings an epi-pen to the program will be required to have an allergy tag on the bag that contains their epi-pen in case a staff member needs to locate it for your child. Each day, the child will need to bring the epi-pen home & then back to the program each day. We cannot hold on to any medication. Staff members are also not responsible for administering ANY medication to child. Should your child need medication during the day at the program, a parent/guardian will need to come to the program to administer it.
